Marine Ball:

Vickie and team have been busy in the planning of this year's Ball. Tickets will be sold at the next Booster Club meeting (Oct 11) as well as a few days at Parkview High School. Details will be sent out as to scheduled dates for this. Cost of tickets: \$25 cadets/ \$35 guest/ Parent if purchased in advance. If tickets are still available they can be purchased at the door for \$50. There will be a ticket cutoff—we can only sell around 500 or so tickets and there will be a cut off period as to allow for final arrangements to be made for the ball (food, linens, tables, chairs, etc). We will also be selling Cadet memory books. Books can be made for any branch of armed forces and will be sold for \$35. Our school will keep \$15 for each book sold. Email will go out with further details in the near future.

Obstacle Course:


